ABOUT THE CAST

He has done acting, sets, lights, sound, stage manager, and assistant directing. Jon's most favorite roles were Mercutio in Romeo and Juliet, and Petruccio in Taming of the Shrew.

RACHEL: Jeanne Robinson is the Mother Goose in her 6th grade classes at Hayden Middle School. She made her first appearance in Magic Circle when she played a wife to the king in The King and I in 1989. Jeanne is a very active young lady in competitive biking, bowling, plays the clarinet and makes wonderful homemade pretzels when not on stage.

CINDY: Kellie Heer appeared in Tom Sawyer as Aunt Polly at Northside School in Montrose. Her first role on the MCP's stage was in Scrooge.
