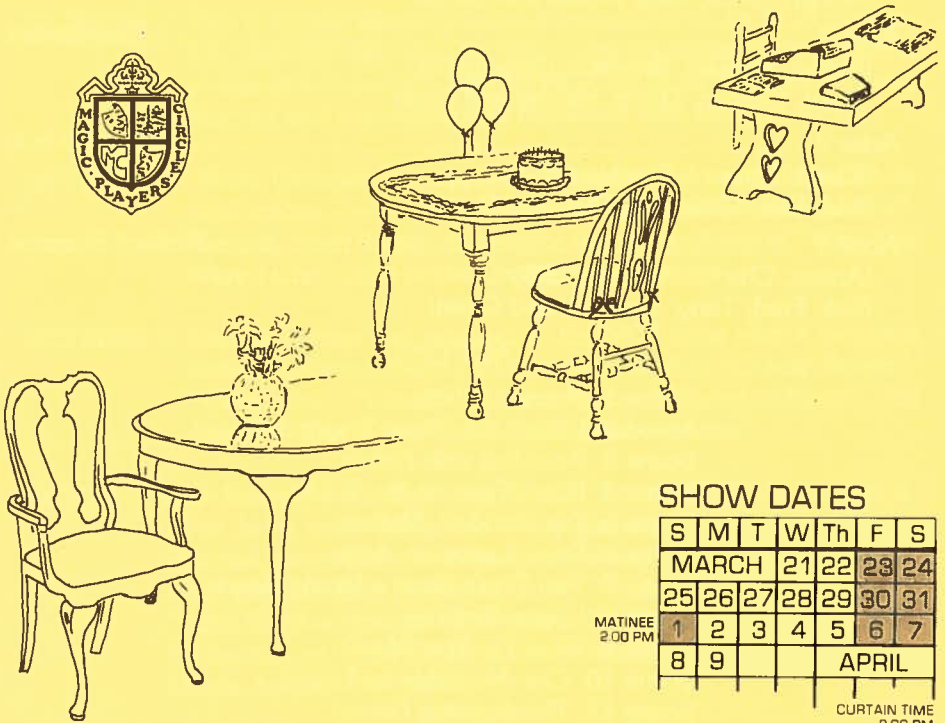

About The Cast

DIRECTORS: Paul and Meredyth Dickerson have been a part of Magic Circle Players since the very beginning 30 years ago. Meredyth performed in the first production and Paul in the second. They have been involved ever since, acting, directing and working on many, many, many different plays. Meredyth has also served on the Board of Governors for MCP. The Dickersons last directed, "I Remember Mama". Meredyth appeared this season in "Bone Chiller"; Paul's most recent role was that of Mayor Shinn in last season's, "Music Man".

ACTRESS 1: This is Carole Zimpel's second appearance in an MCP production. She first appeared in "The Chips are Down", a melodrama produced in Summer, 1989 for MCP. As an Air Force wife, Carole directed and choreographed numerous skits for fund raisers.

ACTRESS 2: Marti Ottinger has appeared previously in two Magic Circle productions — "My Fair Lady" and "I Remember Mama". Her only other theater experience was in the chorus of "Wish You Were Here" while at the University of Missouri.

ACTRESS 3: Debbie Farmer has returned to the MCP stage after a two year hiatus in Alaska. Before that she appeared in "Charlie Brown", "Oklahoma", "Oliver", "My Fair Lady", "Sound of Music", "Lil Abner", "Our Town", and "I Remember Mama".

ACTOR 1: Don Barnett is another very familiar face at MCP. As he puts it, "I've been involved in too many plays to remember." He has directed, acted and worked in almost every capacity for the theater. Most recently Don appeared as Mr. Mushnik, the shopkeeper in "Little Shop of Horrors". Last season he directed "The King and I". He has served on the Board of Governors and as the chairman of the Monte Awards Committee.

ACTOR 2: Although this is Bob Dietrich's first major role in an MCP production, he has appeared in minor parts in "The Rainmaker", "The Sound of Music", and "Little Shop of Horrors". He has also worked with the backstage crews on numerous productions.

ACTOR 3: Dick Shannon is also well-known to MCP patrons. He has appeared in "Mixed Doubles", "Odd Couple", "I Shoulda Thought of That", and "Chapter Two". Dick has also directed for MCP — "Come Blow Your Horn", "The Rainmaker", "Wait Until Dark", "Finigan's Rainbow", and "The Foreigner".
