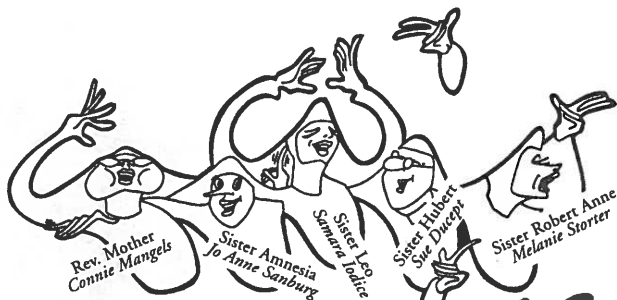

WHO'S WHO IN THE CAST

SISTER MARY REGINA, the beloved Mother Superior of the Little Sisters of Hoboken, is originally from a small county in Ireland called Kilquirk. She headed the pioneering group of religious who established the leper colony in the Mediterranean and later returned to Hoboken as Superior General of the Order. After Nunsense, Mother Superior says she has no desire to continue in the theatre (maybe). But rumor has it that she should consider doing national commercials or a television series to raise money for the Order. Prior to taking her vows, Sister Mary Regina was Connie Mangels. Connie has been a Magic Circle part-timer but she has enjoyed every minute of it and hopes to get more involved in the future. Patrons may remember her as Naughty Nancy in Little Mary Sunshine, and more recently as Ouiser in Steel Magnolias. Connie is from the Eckert area and works for Community Options in Montrose.

SISTER MARY HUBERT entered The Little Sisters of Hoboken upon graduation from Precious Blood Elementary School. Sister Mary Hubert currently serves the Order as Mistress of Novices, training new recruits. Her position is not unlike a drill sergeant, however, she is the first to point out that her approach is more gentle yet firm. Sister Mary Hubert is a little "off-the-wall" at times but this has been attributed to the fact that she was trampled by a camel that went berserk during the annual nativity pageant held in the leper colony. (She was portraying one of the Three Wise Men.) Sister Mary Hubert is the former Sue Ducept. Sue has been in four MPC production before Nunsense. She was in Little Shop of Horrors ('89), Winnie the Pooh ('90), Ice Cream Sunday ('91), and Something's Afoot in ('94). Sue is a bookkeeper at Da-Tel in Montrose. She enjoys weaving and is a motorcycle enthusiast. She also sells Avon on the side.

WHO'S WHO IN THE CAST CONTINUED -

SISTER MARY ROBERT ANNE was a child of a disadvantaged Brooklyn family. After dropping out of Verna's Cashier School, Reverend Mother took pity on poor little Melanie Storter and accepted her in to the Little Sister of Hoboken, where, she became Sister Mary Robert Anne. Today she is one of the most popular Sisters with the New Jersey kids because she speaks their language. Reverend Mother regrets the fact that a lot of this language is unprintable. Sister Robert Anne had a very checkered career prior to entering the convent, including acting stints in Music Man, Little Shop of Horrors, Camelot, The Student Prince, and Man of LaMancha. Her stint with Magic Circle started five years ago and she has enjoyed each and every production. Melanie and her husband operate Dominoes Pizza.

SISTER MARY AMNESIA is truly a lost soul. She arrived at the convent in her habit without a clue as to her identity. . . recalling only that a crucifix fell on her head. It has been said that she resembles Jo Anne Sanburg who tried to learn ventriloquism when she became a Little Sister of Hoboken and previously with the Magic Circle Players. Jo Anne had the leads in H.M.S. Pinafore and My Fair Lady. She has been in many productions as well as being a director and stage manager. Jo Anne is currently giving private piano, guitar and voice lessons. The Order thinks she should seriously think about giving dance lessons also.

SISTER MARY LEO came to the Order from an Illinois farm. She entered the convent to dedicate her life to God through the dance (ballet). Many people think she took her name from the famous "Leotard," but that is not true. She is named after her uncle Leo, a notorious Chicago gangster. Sister Mary Leo thought that by taking his name, The Lord would go easy on him. She is a novice and has much to learn. Before joining the Order, Sister Mary Leo was known as Samara Iodice who tested her dancing ability by appearing in West Side Story and Brigadoon. Her hobbies are singing and writing. Samara is an AGG Engineer with the Soil Conservation Service in Montrose.

DAN GOGGIN the sole author, conceived the idea for the musical Nonsense after the phenomenal success of the Nonsense greeting card line, which he created with Marilyn Farina, the original Mother Superior. Dan has also written scores for the off-Broadway musical Hark; the Broadway production Legend, starring Elizabeth Ashley and F. Murry Abraham; Seven, starring Jane White; the musical A One-Way Ticket To Broadway; Dan has applied for admission to The Little Sisters of Hoboken, but Reverend Mother, Sister Mary Regina says she is much too busy with Nonsense to answer any letters now.

FATHER FLOYD, the Director, was released from his vows as Brother Futon Fouette. This occurred after the Bishop discovered that Brother Futon had used his habit as a parachute to jump from a jet liner onto a burning building to rescue 300 pounds of uncut cocaine from the flames, giving rise to his favorite expression "come fly with me!". Since then, Floyd Heer has directed, worked on, and acted in many MCP productions. Floyd's last appearance on the MCP stage was as Dr. Ralph Morrissey in Send Me No Flowers. He has Directed the following: The Plight Before Christmas; Ducktails and Bobbysox; House at Pooh Corner; Winnie the Pooh; To Gillian on her 37th Birthday; The Toys Take Over Christmas; and Macbeth Did It. Floyd currently is employed at Hartman Brothers Car Quest Auto Parts Store.

SISTER MARY NELDA, our Co-Director, is our convent Activities Director. She was part of the original contingent who established the leper colony served by the order. Sister Mary Nelda achieved much notoriety when she published her first activities book, Two Part Inventions For The Fingerless, which she dedicated to the lepers. Nelda Heer has helped the Order enormously by taking her talents outside the convent walls. Not only has Nelda Co-Directed many shows she has been Chairperson for wardrobe, publicity and is currently Magic Circles historian. . . Nelda is employed at Gibson's discount in Montrose.

BROTHER JON, Assistant Director and Stage Manager, is the Assistant Pastor of Mt. Saint Helen's. He was originally a monk in the Cistercian Abbey of our Lady of Dallas, but was asked to leave after shouting "places, please!" during grand silence. Jon Mitchell was given the job of supervising Nonsense as a penance for past sins in other productions such as his last MCP appearance in Somethings Afoot and in To Gillian On Her 37th Birthday. His theatre education and experience are too numerous to mention so we won't. Jon is owner of Allied Computer Technologies in Montrose.

BROTHER SHAWN, the other Assistant Director, is director of curriculum distribution, and since Mother Superior felt that distribution is distribution, Brother Shawn was put in charge of distributing all Nonsense materials such as scripts, music books etc. In all fairness Shawn Castle is becoming active in Magic Circle. He has appeared in Scrooge II, Send Me No Flowers, and Plight Before Christmas. He was stage manager for Send Me No Flowers also. Shawn also the works for Hartman Brothers.
