WE RECOMMEND SENDING YOUR REGISTRATION ASAP, WE HAVE LIMITED SPACE AND THE CAMPS FILL UP QUICKLY. You will receive a confirmation e-mail when your registration is received.

SUNDAY 2:30 to 5:00pm

The Sunday afternoon makes our very intensive week more productive. We will get to know each other on Sunday and *cast the plays*. Actors will go home with their scripts, knowing what part they will play.

MONDAY –THURSDAY 9:00am – 2:30pm

Starting earlier makes more time for rehearsals, theatre skill building activities and fun!

FOR DRAMA CAMP 2018, ACTORS MUST:

- Attend all days ~ **Week One is June 17 – June 22. Week Two is June 24 – June 29.**
Sunday from 2:30pm to 5:00pm
Monday through Thursday from 9:00am to 2:30pm
Friday from 1:00pm to about 7:15pm (Performances are at 4:00pm and 6:00pm.)
- Be prompt ~ we need every minute so you are ready to do your best in the performances on Friday.
- Not be disruptive or uncooperative ~ there is NO time for whining, complaining or tantrums; *actors can be replaced or written out of the script.*
- Accept whatever part in the play you are given ~ Drama Camp is for LEARNING and you can learn from any part in the production.
- Bring your lunch and a water bottle every day. Wear comfortable clothing and sneakers, dance or gymnastics shoes; no flip flops or open back shoes.

EACH ACTOR NEEDS TO:

- A - Pay ATTENTION, listen & follow all directions.
- C - CONCENTRATE ~ on stage, off stage, back stage, etc.
- T - Be a strong part of our TEAM ~ theatre is a team art.
- O - OBSERVE and learn from everything we do every minute.
- R - Know and perform your RESPONSIBILITIES to every part of the team.

SPECIAL INFORMATION:

- The plays are especially written or adapted for Drama Camp actors.
- Your character has a purpose in telling the story and a personality that needs to come alive on the stage.
- The D in Drama Camp stands for **discipline**. Actors need to **discipline themselves** in many ways every day.
- Drama Camp is not easy. However, it is a wonderful, fantastic and, of course, magical experience.
