SCHEDULE:

- Sunday from 3pm to 5pm
- Monday through Thursday from 9am to 2:30pm
- Friday from 1:00pm to about 7:15pm (Performances are at 4:00pm and 6:00pm.)

EXPECTATIONS:

- Actors attend all days of the camp.
- Actors arrive promptly, prepared for the day.
- Actors bring your lunch and a water bottle every day.
- Actors wear comfortable clothing and sneakers, dance or gymnastics shoes; no flip flops or open back shoes.

DRAMA CAMP TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Actors will accept and learn from any part given.
- Actors will wear any costume that is designed to fit the character that they are playing.
- Actors will not be disruptive or engage in tantrums.
- Actors will not whine or complain.
- Actors will follow all directions.
- Actors will be respectful of fellow actors, all production assistants and the directors.
- Actors will respect the theatre by not making a mess, cleaning up after themselves, and staying out of unassigned areas.

SPECIAL INFORMATION:

- Drama Camp has limited capacity. If there is not an available space for your actor, they will be placed on a waiting list. Rosters will be finalized after receiving payment
- You will receive an email notice regarding payment by April 21. Tuition is \$65 per actor.
- Actors may be asked to bring certain items for their costume. These may include pants, shirts, shoes, and socks.
- The plays are specifically written or adapted for Drama Camp actors, so that all actors have the same number of lines.
- Drama Camp t-shirts are available for \$10 each (optional).
