DEATHTRAP

Sit down. Make yourself comfortable. You've just walked into Deathtrap, the longest running comedy/thriller in Broadway history written by prize winning playwright and novelist Ira Levin. Sidney Bruhl (played by Peter Ambrose) a once highly successful Broadway playwright, is now suffering from severe writer's block and hasn't had a hit show for a long time. He receives a package from a former student, Clifford Anderson (played by Everett Gregory). The package contains an unproduced script that Sidney immediately recognizes as an unmistakable smash hit. At the urging of Sidney's wife Myra (played by Pam Carlson) Sidney instigates a plan to lure Clifford to his home. But does he offer to collaborate on a rewrite or will he murder Clifford and claim the play as his own? What is really the plan? Levin's play is chock full of twists and turns that will keep you guessing until the final curtain. Rounding out the cast is Deb Patterson as Helga Ten Dorp, a spookily accurate clairvoyant, and Keith Laube as Sidney's lawyer, Porter Milgrim. There is some violence, some gun shots and some lightning. Deathtrap is directed by Kim Santich with assistance from Julie Laube. Fool me once, shame on you. Fool me twice, shame on me. Fool me three times....shame on Ira Levin.


