"Why are all the D'Ysquiths dying?" So asks the cast of A Gentleman's Guide to Love and Murder, a merry, murderous musical opening November 1 at Magic Circle.

Spilling over the brim of its posh teacup with lyrical wit, farcical humor, and an infectious musical score, this irresistibly engaging four-time Tony winner turns the audience into accomplices from the very start.

After his mother's passing, low-born and penniless Monty Navarro (Dalyn Pearson) learns he's a distant heir to the D'Ysquith banking fortune. There's just one problem—well, nine of them actually. Nine members of the well-heeled D'Ysquith clan (all played by M.A. Smith) stand between him and his only chance at winning the hand of the beautiful but financially-motivated Sibella Hallward (Wendy Bodwell). A delightfully implausible plan is hatched, and as Monty rockets through the ranks of London's Edwardian-era elite-acquiring an aristocratic fiancée, cousin Phoebe D'Ysquith (Bethany Ward), along the way—his newfound relatives start dropping like flies. From killer bees to skating on thin ice to a tragic weight-lifting accident, the D'Ysquiths meet their maker in the most creative and hilarious ways. While each one brings Monty closer to inheriting a fortune, they also bring him closer to losing his own head—if love doesn't save him first.

Helmed by veteran Magic Circle director Kathy Murdoch, with Everett Gregory stepping into dual

roles as Music Director and Assistant Director, this light-hearted and family- friendly farce is a rollercoaster of wit, suspense and captivating melodies sung by incredible vocalists.

Amy Priest (Miss Shingle), Ruthie Rich (Lady Eugenia) and Tia Brown (Miss Barley) take on three of the more memorable roles in the show, while the ensemble features the exceptional singing talents of Josiah Austin, Tia Brown, Sarah Crawford, Janel Culver, Mike Edwards, Jonathan Heath, Cole Patterson, Jessica Vergari and Hannah Weider. With a delightful blend of clever humor and catchy music, and a quirky cast of characters, A Gentleman's Guide to Love and Murder promises an evening of non-stop laughter and unforgettable entertainment. YOUTH THEATRE



READERS THEATRE




