Matilda Wormwood (link): Age 7-11 / Female / Vocal Range: A3-D5

An imaginative girl who is clever and wise far beyond her years. She has a thirst for learning that cannot be quenched.

Singing Audition: "Naughty" mm 1-34 <u>Score</u> / <u>Accompaniment</u>- See Google Classroom for more.

Singing Audition: Prepare ALL of the song "Quiet" for a possible callback. <u>Score</u> / Accompaniment

Monologue: Matilda will need to memorize Lavender's monologue in Act 2.

Miss Agatha Trunchbull (link): Female or Male / Vocal Range: G4-A2

The tyrannical headmistress at Matilda's school who despises children.

Ideally, actor would be willing to dye his hair green- flexible

Matilda's self-absorbed, negligent mother and an amateur ballroom dancer.

Character requires more dancing skills

Michael Wormwood (link): Age 10-15 / Male / non-singing

Matilda's older brother. He is not very bright and favored by their parents.

Be prepared to cold read scenes & demonstrate character and ability to listen to and apply direction.

Bruce (link): Age 7-13 / Male / Vocal Range C4-E5

Matilda's classmate. He is subject to extreme punishment by Miss Trunchbull.

Monologue: Bruce Monologue-pg 46. Does not need to be memorized

Be prepared to cold read scenes & learn choreography at the audition. Please wear appropriate clothing & shoes.

The Acrobat: Female

A character in a story Matilda tells to Mrs. Phelps who comes to life in their imagination. Non-singing role.

Audition will be mostly movement based.

Be prepared to cold read scenes & learn choreography at the audition. Please wear appropriate clothing & shoes.

Rudolpho: Male / Vocal Range D#3-A4

Mrs. Wormwood's ballroom dance partner.

Singing Audition: Prepare a song of your choice that shows your range. Must be sung with an accompaniment track without other vocals. Bring your own speaker or aux cord.

Be prepared to cold read scenes & learn choreography at the audition. Please wear appropriate clothing & shoes.

Character requires more dancing skills & LOTS of physical comedy

Doctor: Male or Female / Vocal Range C3-A4 / C4-A5

Mrs. Wormwood's Doctor when she goes into labor with Matilda.

Be prepared to cold read scenes & learn choreography at the audition. Please wear appropriate clothing & shoes.

Children's Entertainer: Male or Female / Vocal Range: F#3-Eb4

Please be prepared to list any conflicts from auditions through the performances. This show requires a strong commitment to learning music during rehearsals and practicing at home. Actors must be available for tech week, all dress rehearsals, and performances. Even the smallest scheduling conflict should be recorded on the audition paperwork. If actors are not needed at a rehearsal, they will be notified via Google Classroom prior to the rehearsal. Exceptions may be made for emergency illnesses, but any absence requires a call to a director (Bethany or Wendy). Multiple unexcused absences may lead to reassignment of your role. Teamwork makes the dream work, so please assume you will be needed at every rehearsal.

How to Join Your Google Classroom for MATILDA

Step 1: Sign in to Google

1. Create a Google Account (if you don't have one):

* Go to www.gmail.com and sign up for a Google account. You will need a Google account to join the classroom.

2. Sign in to Your Google Account:

* If you already have a Google account, go to www.gmail.com and sign in with your username and password.

Step 2: Get the Classroom Code

Step 3: Join the Google Classroom

1. Go to Google Classroom:

*Open your browser and go to <u>classroom.google.com</u>. If you're not already signed in, you'll be prompted to sign in with your Google account. You may also download the app.

2. Click the "+" Button:

*On the Google Classroom homepage, look for the "+" sign in the top-right corner and click it.

3. Select "Join Class":

* After clicking the "+" button, select "**Join class**" from the dropdown.

4. Enter the Classroom Code:

* You'll be prompted to enter the **Classroom code** provided by the director.

* Type the code into the text box and click **Join**.

Step 4: Access Important Information

1. Explore the Classroom:

*Once you've joined, you'll land on the "Stream" page. This is where important announcements, reminders, and general updates from the director will be posted.

2. Check the Classwork Tab:

* For audition materials, schedules, and other documents, go to the "Classwork" tab.

* Here, you can find files, assignments, and resources that the director has shared, such as audition songs, rehearsal schedules, costume information, and more.

Step 5: Communicate & Stay Updated

1. Announcements & Updates:

* Keep an eye on the **Stream** tab for regular updates. The director may post new information, reminders, or changes to schedules here.

2. Ask Questions:

* If you have any questions, you can post them in the comments under a relevant announcement, or contact the director directly via email (you'll find the email address under the "People" tab).

Step 6: Get Notifications

1. Enable Email Notifications (Optional):

*You can enable notifications to stay up-to-date with announcements and assignments. To do this:

* Go to the **Settings** by clicking the gear icon in the top-right corner of your Classroom page.

* Scroll down to **Notifications** and make sure you're set to receive the updates you need.
